“A” - KYUKYU (YELLOW STRIPE)		
1	How do students learn in the martial arts?	By listening carefully to the instructors, having a positive attitude, and the best that they can in every class.
2	What should the student do if they have a question or comment for the instructor?	Raise their hand and wait until called upon. They must also be patient sometimes and wait to give comments and questions
3	Should students (or their parents) ask about when they will be promoted?	No. Instead, they should focus on good attendance, working hard, and being enthusiastic about learning.
4	At the end of each class the instructor says " Go kura sama. " What does this mean?	Thank you for working hard and doing your best
5	At the end of each class the students say " Domo arigato gozai mashta. " That means?	Thank you very much

1	What is a place for Karate training called in Japanese?	Dojo
2	What are teachers in the <i>dojo</i> called?	Sensei
3	What is the uniform and belt called in Japanese?	Gi (Uniform) and Obi (Belt)
4	What are the basic positions of dojo etiquette? (The student must demonstrate each position)	Kiotsuke (attention), Rei (Standing Bow), Anza (Cross-leg Sitting), Seiza (Kneeling), Mokuso (Eyes Closed Relaxation), Zarei (Kneeling Bow)
5	What are the “keywords” in the first half of the Dojo Code of conduct?	Respect, Self-defense, Perseverance, Honor, & Responsibility
6	What is the proper way to tie the belt? How do we keep our belt tied?	The student must demonstrate tying their belt. We keep our belt tied by making a habit of checking it often.
7	Escape Techniques	Front Bear Hug (Arms Out), Crossed Wrist Grab

1	When should students bow in the dojo?	1) When entering or leaving the training room 2) When greeting an Instructor or Senior Student 3) When starting or finishing a formal exercise 4) After help from a Sensei or Senior Student
2	On what three animals are the movements of our <i>Karate</i> style based?	The Tiger, Crane, and Dragon
3	How do you count to ten in Japanese or <i>Nihongo</i> ?	Ich, Nee, San, Chee, Go, Rook, Sich, Hach, Kyu, Jyu
4	How can each student help to make the dojo a clean and pleasant place to learn?	By keeping themselves and their equipment neat and clean
5	What does the word " <i>Karate</i> " mean?	Empty Hands (self-defense without weapons)
6	What does the word " <i>Sanchin</i> " mean?	Three Battles
7	How can the student be respectful in the dojo?	By using good manners and treating the instructors and other students well.
8	Escape Techniques	Sucker Punch, Front Bear Hug (Arms In)

1	How do students qualify for a rank or belt promotion?	They must: 1) Learn the required skills and knowledge, 2) show development of mind, body and spirit 3) attend the required minimum number of classes
2	What is your present rank in Japanese?	Nanakyu (Changes with each promotion)
3	How do you say "right foot forward" in Japanese?	Migi Ashi Mae

4	How do you say "left foot forward" in <i>Nihongo</i> ?	Hidari Ashi Mae
5	What do the keywords in first half of the Dojo Code of conduct mean?	Respect - Treating everyone with courtesy and consideration. Self-defense - Having self-control to use martial arts skills ONLY for protection. Perseverance - Succeeding through dedication, hard work, and always doing your best. Honor – Knowing what is right and wrong and choosing what is right. Responsibility - Taking action when things need to be done and accepting your results.
6	What is the name of the style of Karate you are studying?	Uechi-Ryu Karatedo (also known as Shohei-Ryu)
7	What does <i>O-negai shimas</i> mean?	"May I have your attention?" or "May I do this?"
8	Escape Techniques	Rear Choke, Headlock

4	What is the name of the association which governs <i>Shohei-Ryu Karatedo</i> around the world?	The Okinawa Karate-Do Kyokai (Association) or OkiKuKai
5	Who are the Owners and Chief Instructors of the ZenQuest Martial Arts Center?	Senseis Mark and Connie Flynn
6	What is considered the single most important aspect of <i>Karate</i> training?	Sanchin Kata
7	What does the word " <i>Kata</i> " mean?	Pattern or form

2	What is the meditation performed at the end of each class called and what is its purpose?	Mokuso is performed to relax and clear the mind.
3	What are Sensei Mark's and Sensei Connie's Ranks?	Sensei Mark - Nanadan (7th degree black belt) Sensei Connie - Nanadan (7th degree black belt)
4	What does the word " <i>Senpai</i> " mean?	Senior student/ Leader
5	What does the word " <i>Kohai</i> " mean?	Junior student
6	What does " <i>Yakusoku Kumite</i> " mean?	Prearranged Sparring (sparring drills)
7	What does " <i>Jiyu Kumite</i> " mean?	Freestyle Sparring

1	What is the correct breathing method used in <i>Sanchin Kata</i> ?	Breathing-in through the nose, and out with short burst through the mouth with striking movements, making a "hissing" sound. The timing of breathing should be as natural as possible.
2	How do you say "excuse me" in <i>Nihongo</i> ?	Sumi masen
3	How do you say "Please do" or "Be my guest" in <i>Nihongo</i> ?	Dozo
4	What are the names and ranks of Senseis Mark's and Connie's teachers?	Sensei Toshio Higa and Sensei Shigeru Takamiyagi (both Hanshi Jyudan-10 th degree black belt)
5	Where did <i>Kanbun Uechi</i> study Pan-gai-noon?	Fujian Province, Southern China
6	What is the meaning of <i>Kime</i> ?	A sudden burst of energy, focusing the forces of the mind, body and spirit on a point. <i>Kime</i> combines muscle contraction, breath, technique, speed, timing, and distancing.
7	What rank is reserved for Black Belts that are 15 years of age or younger?	Jun Shodan
8	How long did <i>Kanbun Uechi</i> study in China?	13 years (1897 to 1910)
9	Who was <i>Kanbun Uechi's</i> teacher?	A Shaolin Master named <i>Shu Shi Wa</i>
10	What are the five Master ranks (from sixth to tenth degree)?	Rokudan, Nanadan, Hachidan, Kyudan, and Jyudan
11	What does " <i>Wakarimasen</i> " mean?	"I do not understand" or "I do not know"
12	Escape Techniques	Double Front Choke (Wall), Double Lapel-Grab (Wall)

4	What are the other six <i>kata</i> in <i>Shohei-ryu</i> ?	Kanshiwa, Kanshu, Seichin, Seiryu, Kanchin, and Ryuko

6	What are the dates when <i>Uechi-Ryu's</i> first two grand masters began teaching?	<i>Uechi Kanbun</i> - 1908 (China) <i>Uechi Kanei</i> - 1940 (Japan)
7	Where and when did <i>Uechi Kanei</i> begin his study of <i>Karate</i> ?	Wakayama Prefecture in Japan in 1930
8	What are the life-span dates of <i>Uechi-Ryu's</i> first two grand masters?	<i>Uechi Kanbun</i> - 1877 to 1948 <i>Uechi Kanei</i> - 1911 to 1991
9	Give the years for when the terms " <i>Uechi-Ryu</i> " and " <i>Shohei-Ryu</i> " were each first used?	<i>Uechi-Ryu</i> – 1940 <i>Shohei-Ryu</i> – 1995
10	What are the Japanese words for the Dojo Code?	<i>Sonkei</i> – Respect, <i>Mamorimas</i> - Self-defense, <i>Ganbarimas</i> – Perseverance, <i>Meiyo</i> – Honor, <i>Sekinin</i> – Responsibility, <i>Yudaneru</i> - Dedication, <i>Gaman</i> - Patience, <i>Yuuki</i> - Courage, <i>Yokusei</i> - Self-Control, & <i>Kenson</i> - Humility
11	What are the three “major” styles of <i>Karate</i> in Okinawa today?	<i>Uechi-ryu, Goju-ryu, and Shorin-ryu</i>
12	What is the meaning of <i>Bushido</i> or the Warrior Spirit?	To train the mind, body and spirit to be pure and strong.
13	What are the three <i>Bunkai(s)</i> in <i>Shohei-Ryu</i> ?	<i>Kanshiwa Bunkai, Seisan Bunkai, and Sanseiryu Bunkai.</i>
14	What are the Japanese words for Tiger, Crane and Dragon?	Tiger - <i>Tora (or Ko)</i> , Crane - <i>Tsuru</i> , Dragon - <i>Ryu</i>
