# **Team Sponsorships 4.0**

Once again, ZenQuest is opening it's sponsorship program for the premier fight team in the Berkshires. Sponsoring 'Team-Z' is a great way to support the fighters and gym in their endeavors...AND a way to get your own name out there, too. Sponsorship funds are used to cover expenses including training, travel, meals, licensing fees, supplies and equipment. With new fighters preparing to make debuts soon, these sponsorships are essential to continuing the success that we've seen in recent years.

**The Team** - In the early stages of it's MMA adventures the fight team produced mixed results. We had some spectacular wins, and some memorable defeats. After moving and rebranding itself, the gym became much more organized and the

competition team began to take things to a whole new level. Since then, we've amassed a winning record of 11-6 with several of those fights for amateur titles. At this point, we've picked up no less than three regional amateur titles including the lightweight belt for 'Reality Fighting', New England's biggest MMA promotion. This took place in what some considered the 'fight of the night' in the 10,000 seat capacity Mohegan Sun Arena.



The team also competes in other combat sports events like Jiu-jitsu tournaments and Kickboxing bouts. We currently has several new fighters preparing to make their debuts later this year!

Sponsorship - All sponsorship donations are used to cover expenses incurred by the fighters and coaching staff including training, travel, meals, and equipment. Sensei Joe Gilbert will be running a clinic on Uechi-Ryu Karate at ZenQuest on Saturday March 21st. Sensei Joe started training at the Okinawan Karate School (the original name for ZenQuest)

back in 1973. He has trained and taught consistently since then and has a longstanding dojo in Bennington, Vermont. On that trip Sensei Joe was promoted to 8th Dan or 8th Degree Black Belt Master of the traditional Okinawan style.

As usual, the 2-Stripe Black Belt under Jiu-jitsu wizard Demian Maia provided an incredible learning experience in the three hour hands-on clinic he provided. Professor or instructor Moraes covered many strategies and principles for the single-leg takedown, passing the guard, half-

guard, and 'side-control' position.



After demonstrating a move, Professor Silvio typically checked to see if anyone had any questions or concerns about the technique by asking if there was "any doubt." However, in seeing the effect that the move usually had on the person receiving the move, there wasn't.

**Levels** - There are different levels of sponsorships available. They range from those appropriate for individuals, to something more for businesses or groups.

Sponsorship levels are as follows:

**Silver -** \$100 for a small listing (i.e. a name of a person or company) on the website, Team shirt, fight banner, etc. Also includes one free Walkout shirt, and 20% discount on any additional shirts.

**Gold -** \$200 for a medium listing or logo. Also includes two free shirts and 25% discount on any additional shirts.

**Platinum -** \$500 for a large listing or logo. Also includes three free shirts and 30% discount on any additional shirts.

**Diamond -** \$1,000 for an extra-large listing or logo. Also includes four free shirts and 40% discount on any additional shirts.

**Walkout Shirts** - These high-quality, custom shirts are regularly \$30 each, but discounted according to sponsorship levels. They feature the gym and parent organizations on their front, with all sponsors appearing on the back. These can be used for running, training, or other activities...or just casually as a t-shirt.
