Blue Kru

ZenQuest's Muay Thai Guru, Mark DellaGrotte, dropped in for a two hour seminar back on Saturday, September 28th. As always, he provided an incredible opportunity to learn about the 'Art of Eight Limbs' that is Muay Thai. About twenty students showed up for the two hour clinic, which proved to be packed with important principles

and strategies of the art. Among the material covered in the clinic were eight essential defensive tactics like knee blocks. leg checks, parrying, pivoting, 'hollowing-out' and 'fading' or leaning back. Toward the end of the seminar Kru Mark had the participants drill something he calls the 'Vegas Shuffle' where one partner would ask the other for combinations of punches and kicks and



then throw an attack towards them to get them to execute one of the essential defensive maneuvers covered earlier.

At the end of the clinic, Kru Mark had Coaches Connie and Mark demonstrate a short version of a ceremonial ritual called the 'Wai Kru' for the group. This is a traditional dance like routine to show respect to ones teacher and organization. When the demonstration was over Kru Mark promoted Coaches Connie and Mark to Blue Monkol (headband.) Kru Mark also asked them to accompany him on his next trip to Thailand in 2020!

Tuition Adjustments

To keep pace with ever increasing expenses, the tuition at ZenQuest is being adjusted slightly. The basic adult tuition will increase by \$10 per month, with typical discounts for three, six or twelve month enrollments and Easy Pay. The basic children's tuitions and basic adult family rate will increase by \$5 per month. Children's family rates will remain unchanged.

These tuition rates will take affect November 1st, 2019. All payments before then will be under the old rates, so students and parents may want to consider taking advantage and committing to longer enrollments up to that point. This is also a good time to consider enrolling in our Easy Pay payment plan. Doing so will lock in existing tuition rates for as long as you remain enrolled in it.

Demian Maia will step into the UFC octagon for the 26th time soon to face Ben Askren. Askren, with a record of 19-1, is a grappler with heavy wrestling experience. This should prove to be an interesting challenge for the Jiu-jitsu wizard, who's made wrestling a big part of his strategies in recent times. Twelve of Demian's 26 wins in the Octagon have been by submission. The bout will be the main event in the UFC's Fight Night on October 26 in Singapore.

This could be Demian's last MMA fight, capping off a long career of using Jiu-jitsu and essentially 'restraining' many of the best fighters in the world. This after a very successful run in grappling competition, earning five world titles and winning the prestigious ADCC.
